- Report reviewed all costs, routes, duration, and ridership for our transportation services
- Consultant reported busing overall to be as efficient as possible (both cost and overall bus utilization) given timing and traffic within the City
- The Boston METCO routes, which encompass a large portion of Boston, and the Private School Routes, which encompass all of Newton, are required exceptions



Transportation Report - Traffic and Safety

- Consultant reviewed a majority of of schools and made some general recommendations on safety
- Recommendations included: Separation of walk/bike, yellow buses, Special Education vans, parking, and pick-up and drop-off activity
- Other comments included lack of staff parking and adding and updating signage around schools
- Specific comments and recommendations regarding Newton South traffic, circulation and safety



3 Feasible Options Proposed

- Transportation consultant's options for new start times, incorporating the following goals:
 - Target 8:30 high school start time
 - Minimize elementary and middle school changes
 - Maintain instructional time K-8
 - Minimize traffic congestion and impact
 - Minimize student time on vehicles
 - Cost neutral for bussing

Option 1 - Analysis

Advantages

- Minimal K-8 time impact
- Desirable later HS start time (9:00)

Disadvantages

- 3:45 HS end time
- MS times before 8 AM
- Must add 6 buses
 (\$599,400) or adjust
 private school times

Option 2 - Analysis

Advantages

• Desirable later HS start time (8:45)

Disadvantages

- 3:30 HS end time
- Very early K-8 start times
- Some MS and ELL buses dropped off early
- Must add 6 buses (\$599,400) or adjust private school times

Option 3 - Advantages & Disadvantages

Advantages

- Bus routing improvements
 - 2 Boston buses can cover morning ES route
 - Additional late buses possible for MS & HS
 - Possible shorter bus routes
 - Tight routing may prevent growth

Disadvantages

- 8:10 HS start time
- 9:00 ES start time
- Varied MS times (7:50-9:00)
- Some MS and ELL buses dropped off early
- May require 2 additional HS buses (\$198,800)



Next Steps for Start Time

- Continue review of feasible options by Transportation department
- Partnership with NTA, elementary/middle leaders, afterschool providers, private schools re: options
- Communication with K-12 families re: benefits & impacts
- Exploration of strategies to minimize impacts
 - Adjustments/improvements to feasible options presented
 - Explore increasing elementary before school and/or afterschool capacity

Next Steps for HS Schedule Implementation

- Collective bargaining between NTA and NPS ongoing
- Continue school-based work on flex blocks, professional development, curricular planning, IEP alignment, and course adjustments
- Further exploration of implementation with current or later start times in Fall 2020
 - Significant positive impact on student wellness and academic support
