# 2023-2024 Budget (See Proposed 2023-24 NSHS PTSO Budget)

- Small budget changes here and there from last year: largest dollar increases are in Student Appreciation/Community Engagement and Faculty Appreciation/Hospitality; School Support will be funneled through Tami and not sent individually from the PTSO; SouthFest will be moved from overall fundraising to its own targeted fundraising line -PTSO will contribute \$1500 to SouthFest and the remaining dollars will come from targeted fundraising.
