1. Welcome/Introductions

2. Financials

- Income YTD: \$47,000 in dues received to date, including directed giving and senior activities
- Expenses YTD: \$1,044.24 in Communications, \$351.56 in Community Engagement, \$1,058.16 in Hospitality, and \$881.47 in Office Expenses.
- Grant Update: Some possibilities for new members for the Grants Committee..
 Received Springboard grant request. Share photos of past grant requests and class of 2022 gift to help with dues messaging.

3. Hospitality

- First event is September 28. PTSO will provide coffee and desserts and staff will go back to their departments for a potluck. PTSO will ask for parent-provided boxes of coffee.

4. Back to School Night

5. Celebrate South & Boosters Update

- October 21-28
- Last year: PTSO provided donuts and ice cream during passing time on

subsequent days. PTSO made a large banner with all the kids names. Michelle decorated the fence with cups. The Art department made a QR code with a calendar with the week's events, there was a dance performance and Katani Sumner sang.

- This year: Booster Club games, raffles, giveaways at different sporting events, rally towels for the games.. All teams will consolidate senior nights to be that week. Friday night is football, Saturday is boys soccer.
- Seniors planning a homecoming on October 21 and wondering about parent chaperones.
 - o Frosh Play is October 19-21
 - o Hall of Fame Dinner is October 21 in Student Center
 - Turf Dedication possibly Saturday October 28
- Boosters are starting a membership drive which will provide a baseline of funding for teams and provide members with a fast pass to games.
